Students that want to enrol to the Bachelor in Tourism Science specializing in Food and wine and Tourism, Academic Year 2016/2017, must take an entrance test to verify their basic knowledge, according to art. 6 paragraph 1, DM 270/2004.

The first 45 candidates on the merit ranking will be part of the first group of students enrolled to the Bachelor in Tourism Science specializing in Food and wine and Tourism, Academic Year 2016/2017.

All the application forms must be submitted by March 3rd, 2016 to April 15th, 2016 via web following the instructions on the website <u>www.unimol.it</u>, through the Student's Web Portal.

Those who are interested must register first on the Student's Web Portal and then log in the reserved area using the personal access keys released at the end of the online registration process (username and password).

Through the menu at the left side of the page enter the area "Secretariat" and, through the function "Entrance Test", they have to click on the button "Registration". Then they can go on filling in the application form that must be printed and preserved to be showed the day of the entry test, during the identification procedure.

Those who will find difficulties can send an e-mail to daimmo@unimol.it .

Users that are already registered must directly do the login using their personal credentials (username and password).

Those who have lost their personal credentials to enter the Web Portal can request them to the Administrative Office or through the function "Password Recovery" on the Web Portal homepage (url: https://unimol.esse3.cineca.it/Start.do)

By April 15th, 2016, all those who are interested must provide for the payment of $20,00 \in$ at any bank, as participation fee for the entrance test, using the "MAV" that can be printed from the Student's Web Portal.

To all those who will complete the enrolment to the Bachelor in Tourism Science specializing in Food and wine and Tourism, the participation fee to the entry test will be deducted from the first

instalment of the enrolment fees of the Academic Year 2016/2017.

The receipt of the payment and the application form should be exhibited on the entrance test's day. The receipt alone does not constitute enrolment to the test.

The candidate may choose between the Italian and English version of the entrance test; the entrance test will be composed of fourty (40) questions divided as follows:

- twenty (20) questions about general culture and basic subjects as geography, history, economics, law and other social and humanistic disciplines;
- twenty (20) questions about the following subjects: agriculture, feeding, landscape, enology, communication, tourism and marketing

For the purposes of the test evaluation are taken into account the following criteria:

- 1 point for each correct answer;
- - 0.5 point for each wrong answer;
- 0 point for each not answered.

Two hours will be available to the candidate to complete the test.

The entry test will be held on April 27th, 2016 at 11 a.m. in Termoli (CB) at the University of Molise, via Duca degli Abruzzi s.n.c..

To allow the identification procedure, the candidates have to be at indicated the address

at 10 am bringing with them a valid identity document, the application form and the receipt of the payment of the participation fee.

Candidates without a valid identification document or that payed the participation fee after the deadline (April 15th, 2016) will not be admitted to the entrance test.

Those who will be absent, for any reason, at the closing time of the identification procedure, will be considered as renouncers.

This notice is an official convocation and all the applicants won't receive other communications.

The outcome of the test will be published online on the Official List of the University of Molise (URL <u>http://www.albo.unimol.it</u>) and will be available at the Student Offices of the University of Molise (offices of Campobasso, Pesche and Termoli), and at the Secretary's Office of the Biosciences and Environment Department and on the University of Molise website too (URL dipbioter.unimol.it/scienze_turistiche).

The outcome of the test will be published on May 16th, 2016 and will have the value of an official notification for all the applicants.
