DECREES

Art.1

Activation

A public selection is announced at University of Molise for the admission to the **following Ph.D. Programs - 34th cycle, academic year 2018/2019**, with administrative headquarters at the University of Molise:

- **PhD in Biosciences and Territory (DOT1339138);**
- **PhD in Innovation and Management of Public Resources (DOT1339381);**
- **PhD in Translational and Clinical Medicine (DOT1439800)**
- **International PhD in Agricultural Technology and Biotechnology (DOT1339335).**

Annexes 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, which constitute an integral part to this notice, indicate, for each course, Coordinators, research themes, available positions, admission procedures, the calendar of the selection process and test days, and the curricula.

The PhD Programs have a three-year duration, beginning on 1 November 2018 .

The number of positions with scholarship may be increased as a result of the participation of the University in the procedure for the submission of applications for funding, as provided for by the MIUR's Directorial Decree no. 1090 of 4 May 2018 on "Innovative doctorates with industrial characterization" - PON FSE-FESR "Research and Innovation 2014-2020" - Axis I "Human capital" - Action I.1, aimed at promoting and strengthening high education and postgraduate specialization at doctoral level in line with the needs of the national productive system and with the National Strategy for Smart Specialization 2014-2020 approved by the European Commission.

Pursuant to art. 9 par. 1 of the MIUR Directorial Decree no. 1090 of May 4, 2018 "only graduates shortlisted for the PhD courses in the Academic Year 2018/2019, 34th cycle can be awarded with additional doctoral scholarships, based on the funds referred to in the Directorial Decree no. 1090/2018". In case the shortlist is divided into curricula (where this provision is explicitly mentioned in the public notices issued by the universities), the criterion of scientific relevance will also be taken into account in the allocation of the additional PhD scholarships ".

Furthermore, the number of scholarships indicated in each PhD Course Profile may be increased, with subsequent measures, following further funding also obtained from public or private external Bodies and / or following the availability of additional resources, without prejudice to the deadline for submission of applications for admission.

The present announcement has the value of notification for all purposes .Any changes, updates or additions to its content will be published on the University's website <http://www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/bandi-in-evidenza/> and on the University's Register.

Failure to comply with the rules contained in this announcement will result in exclusion from the selection process.

The University is not to be held liable for any dispersed communications due to postal or telematic errors in data transmission, to the candidates' disclosure of inaccurate personal contact details, and failure or delay in communicating any changes to them.

This announcement is written in Italian and English in accordance with the provisions of the applicable regulations and the University's Regulation.

Art.2

Admission requirements

Candidates who hold or will have obtained the following qualifications by 31 October 2018, may participate in the selection, without any age or citizenship limitations :

- a) Degree obtained according to the previous Italian education system under the Italian Ministerial Decree no. 509/1999 (Italian "laurea vecchio ordinamento");
- b) Master's degree pursuant to the Italian Ministerial Decree no. 409/1999
- c) Master's degree pursuant to the Italian Ministerial Decree no. 270/2004;
- d) A similar qualification equivalent to the aforementioned second-level academic qualifications or declared equivalent by the Italian authorities (for the sole purpose of participation in the selection process of the PhD Programs);

and candidates who hold an academic qualification, obtained outside of Italy by the expiration date of this announcement, corresponding to any of the qualifications required for the specific PhD course candidates wish to apply for, presented together with the application and with the relevant documentation recognized as equivalent by the Selection Panel.

The attached forms are an integral part of this announcement, and specify the type of qualifications required for participation in the selection procedure and any additional requirements for each PhD program.

All candidates are admitted to the selection subject to verification of self-certified declarations pursuant to the Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000 and subsequent modifications.

At any time during the selection procedure, the University may carry out checks on the veracity of the declarations given even after the start of the PhD courses. The University may at any time exclude candidates from the selection procedure or from the PhD program with a motivated provision of the Rector, without prejudice to the penal responsibilities deriving therefrom.

Candidates who obtain the academic qualification required for access to the PhD Course **by 31 October 2018** will be admitted to the selection subject to confirmation .

In the event that these candidates pass the selection tests and enroll in a doctoral course, after having obtained the qualification and no later than 30 days from the start date of the course, they must send the relevant documentation to the **Students' Registrar (diulio@unimol.it; cefaratti @ unimol.it)** including: a dated and signed self-certification concerning the achievement of the qualification (or a certificate, only in case of an academic qualification obtained in non-EU countries), with a copy of a valid photo identification document, specifying:

- the name of the University which issued the qualification

- the date of graduation,
- the type of degree (based on the previous Italian education system or further reforms),
- final grade.

Art.3

Academic qualifications obtained in countries other than Italy

The Admissions Panel of the selection process is responsible for establishing the eligibility of the foreign qualifications for the sole purpose of participating in the selection and enrollment in the PhD program, in compliance with the current and relevant legislation in Italy and in the country where the qualification has been issued and with international treaties or agreements for the recognition of qualifications in higher education.

By applying for the selection process, candidates implicitly and concurrently request for the verification of the eligibility of their foreign qualifications. To this end, Italian and foreign candidates holding a foreign academic qualification are required to attach the following documents to the application:

- a) a degree certificate with transcript including the candidate's exams and final grades, and its translation into English or Italian.
- c) any other relevant document for the assessment of the qualification eligibility (Diploma Supplement etc.)

In case they are selected, Italian or foreign candidates with a qualification obtained abroad are required to present, **by March 30, 2019**, under penalty of exclusion from the course, a "**dichiarazione di valore in loco (DV)**" of their foreign qualification and the degree certificate with transcript, translated and legalized by the Italian diplomatic bodies of the country where the certificate was issued. The "dichiarazione di valore" (DV) must certify that the qualification held is valid in the country of attainment for enrollment in an academic course similar to a doctoral course.

If the aforementioned "dichiarazione di valore in loco" (DV) is not available by the deadline, a document proving that the candidate has requested the issue of the DV to the relevant diplomatic body must be presented. The PhD student shall submit the "dichiarazione di valore in loco" (DV) as soon as possible .

Art.4

Application for the selection process

1. Applicants to the selection process shall submit their documents in plain paper, based on the attached model form and including the required documentation, addressed to the **Magnifico Rettore dell'Università degli Studi del Molise, Area Innovazione e Sviluppo, Via Francesco de Sanctis s.n.c., 86100 Campobasso (Rector of the University of Molise, Innovation and Development Dept.)**, and must be received no later than **September 25, 2018**, via one of the following means:

- ▶ by registered mail with receipt,
- ▶ or certified e-mail (PEC) by sending it to the University of Molise's certified address amministrazione@cert.unimol.it pursuant to and in accordance with the procedures established by the current Italian legislation,

► or personally handed over to the University's "Ufficio Protocollo" (Information Protocol and Archives Office of the University of Molise) no later than **September 25, 2018**.

In case of shipping the application by registered mail **THE POSTMARK DATE OF THE RECEIVING OFFICE SHALL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS A VALID PROOF OF RECEIPT.** Applications received after the given deadline will not be considered.

Applications can be submitted in person at the University's "Ufficio Protocollo" (Information Protocol and Archives Office of the University of Molise) on the following days and times: Monday to Friday, from 9.00 to 12.00.

2. Applications sent by the given deadline via Certified Electronic Mail to the University of Molise's certified email address: amministrazione@cert.unimol.it , s shall be considered valid only if the applicant's email address is itself certified (PEC), and, in accordance with the current and relevant laws, applications sent through ordinary email accounts will not be accepted even if addressed to the University of Molise's certified email address .

3. **Foreign candidates or residents abroad** shall submit their applications for admission to the selection process to the following email address phd_receipt@unimol.it **no later than September 25, 2018**.

4. The application form must include the candidate's personal details, date and place of birth, residence and their preferred domicile for the selection process, as well as their telephone number, e-mail address or certified email address, their citizenship, tax code, the exact wording of the PhD program they wish to apply for, its corresponding code and the indication of only one chosen PhD curriculum .

In the same application form, candidates must declare the following, pursuant to art. 46 of the Italian Presidential Decree 445 of 28/12/2000:

- the University where the degree was obtained;
- the qualification held, the final grade and date of accomplishment;
- the academic year of graduation;
- or alternatively the statement that the required qualification will be presented by October 31, 2018,
- or alternatively, in case the qualification was obtained from a non-Italian university, the name of the foreign qualification to be evaluated for equivalence to the required Italian qualifications;
- not to be enrolled in another doctoral course;
- that the candidate is not simultaneously enrolled in another course (undergraduate course, non-medical specialization course, postgraduate degree or diploma course, another specialization course) which is incompatible with the PhD course, or, if so, that they commit to suspend their attendance to such incompatible course for the entire duration of the PhD program;
- knowledge of a foreign language.

The application must include:

1. For applicants holding a degree obtained in countries other than Italy, a degree certificate with transcript or a description of the degree with full transcript;
2. For applicants holding a degree obtained in Italy, a self-certification of possessing the admission requirement pursuant to articles 46 and 47 of the Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000 and subsequent modifications ;
3. a photocopy of a valid ID document;
4. A signed Europass-format Curriculum vitae et studiorum (the Europass template can be downloaded at: <https://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/it/documents/curriculum-vitae>);

5. The qualifications and documents that may be deemed admissible for admission and a list of all the presented documentation;
6. Scientific publications and a list of all the publications attached to the application;
7. **The applicant's research project with a title (only if required by the selection tests specific to each PhD Program)**

Publications in languages other than Italian, English, French, German and Spanish must be presented in their original language and translated into Italian.

In the case that they are in a language other than Italian, English, French, German and Spanish, certificates issued by the competent authorities of the State of which the foreign applicant is a citizen must be translated and legalized by the competent Italian consular bodies.

For foreign scholarship holders, a certificate confirming their entitlement to the scholarship funded by a foreign country must be attached to the application.

Applications that are still incomplete with regard to the application form/forms and / or in the mandatory attachments at September 25, 2018 shall be excluded.

Applications that are incomplete, irregular or not transmitted according to the terms and conditions of this article shall not be considered valid.

Applications containing undated and/or unsigned self-certifications shall also be excluded.

No supplementary documentation received after the deadline will be accepted, under any circumstance.

ART. 5

Candidates with disabilities

Pursuant to Law 104/92, as supplemented by Law 17/99, and Law 170/2010, applicants with disabilities or Specific Learning Disorders (DSA) can support, where provided for in the selection process for admission to the chosen doctorate, the admission test with personalized supports, making a request by completing the relevant form available at the following link to be attached to the application form and to be sent strictly within the deadline of the announcement, <https://www.unimol.it/wp-content/uploads/2015/07/MODULO-RICHIESTA-AUSILI-NUMERO-PROGRAMMATO2.pdf> specifying the supports, aids or compensatory measures required (additional time for written tests).

It is also mandatory to attach to the abovementioned form the certifications related to disability or DSA as well as the documentation useful for the purpose of personalized supports such as certification pursuant to Law 104/1992; the certification of civil disability; the certification diagnosis of DSA issued after the majority of age by structures of the NHS or by specialists and facilities accredited by the same. The request must be drawn up following the indications available in the online application procedure for the selection.

Sensitive data will be kept and processed with the confidentiality provided for by the European Regulation n.679/2016.

ART. 6

Selection process

The selection process, the criteria for the evaluation of the tests and the relative timetable are indicated in the forms relating to each PhD program, attached to this announcement and an integral part of the same, as well as in the pages dedicated to each course published on the website [http: / /www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/](http://www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/). The information provided in the individual forms constitutes an official convocation for all legal purposes.

The dates of the tests indicated in the course sheet constitute, in effect, an official convocation, therefore the candidates will not receive any convocation or communication regarding the exams. To take the tests, candidates must present themselves at the venue, day and time indicated in the aforementioned form, showing a valid identification document (identity card, passport, driving license). Candidates are not required to participate in the assessment of qualifications.

The oral tests, only and exclusively if foreseen in the card concerning the chosen doctoral course, can be carried out also in a language other than Italian. Any oral examination is public.

The attribution of the scores to the individual tests, including the minimum score to be admitted to any written or oral tests, is indicated in the forms relating to the individual PhD courses.

The result of the evaluation and the subsequent verification of admission to the next selective test will be available on the web at <http://www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/>, starting from the date declared in the specific sheets of each course.

The final score is given by the sum of the points reported in the evaluation of the qualifications and of the eventual written and / or oral exam.

Special provisions for candidates residing abroad : candidates residing abroad, can take the oral exam at a distance, only and exclusively if provided for in the PhD program, using the videoconferencing tool (Skype) or system similar. Interested candidates, wishing to make use of videoconferencing, in this case, the interested parties must make a request by filling in a special request by videoconference interview form attached to this announcement, together with a photo size and color passport recently. The application for admission must indicate their Skype contact to the selection by declaring to ensure the use of a webcam to allow their identification to the Commission of selection. The candidate must be available at the personal address, previously communicated, on the day for the oral examination, according to the indications given in the calendar published on the website indicated in the sheet. The Commission has the right to agree with the candidate a precise timetable for the start of the interview. For identification purposes and under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure, each candidate is required to identify himself, by presenting the same identity document already transmitted, as a copy, as an attachment to the application. The failure to communicate the personal address, the lack of connection, the unavailability of the candidate on the day or at the scheduled time or the failure to display a valid identification document pursuant to the preceding paragraph are grounds for exclusion from the selection procedure.

The University of Molise declines any responsibility for the possibility that technical reasons prevent the regular conduct of the oral examination.

Oral distance tests, such as those carried out at the time, are public.

ART. 7

Examination boards

The Competition Examination Boards for admission to the PhD programs are appointed by the Rector with their own decree and are composed in accordance with the provisions of the current Regulation on the Ph.D. program of the University of Molise.

Their composition can be consulted at <http://www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/>.

The Examination Boards will not send any personal communication to the candidates regarding the outcome of the competition tests: it will be the sole responsibility of the candidates to inform themselves by the methods described in the previous articles of this announcement.

ART. 8

Ranking

The winning candidates will be admitted to the PhD course, after the approval of the selection documents, according to the ranking order for each of the various curricula included in each PhD program and up to the coverage of the places available for each PhD program.

In the event that, in the ranking for a single curriculum envisaged in a doctorate, not all the places banned are covered, the Commission will perform a comparative assessment of the tests and qualifications of the candidates who are suitable but not winners in the ranking of the other curricula of the same doctorate in order to cover all the banned places.

The rankings, after the approval of the bankruptcy documents, will be available on the "Doctorates" page → Bandi of the "Research" section of the website <http://www.unimol.it> and on the University Register.

The publication of the ranking list has the value of official communication in all respects and no communication will be sent to the candidates regarding the publication of the ranking list and the deadline for enrollment.

In case of equality in the assessment, it precedes the youngest candidate according to the art. 2 co. 9 of Law 191/1998, without prejudice to the criterion of precedence provided for the award of the PhD scholarship, reported in art. 9 of this announcement. If the candidate is a winner in several rankings, he / she will have to opt for only one doctoral course. The choice of the doctoral course, carried out at the time of enrollment, is final and will not be possible in any way to modify it.

ART. 9

Admission to courses

The winning candidates are admitted to the chosen doctorate course according to the ranking order for each of the various curricula included in each doctorate and up to the coverage of the places available for each PhD program.

For places reserved for Scholarship holders from foreign institutions and graduates in foreign universities, a separate ranking is required.

Failure to complete the enrollment, within 15 days from the date of publication of the ranking, will result in the forfeiture of the right to admission to the Course. In this case, the posts left vacant are assigned to those who hold a useful position in the ranking of merit.

In case of equal points, the following criteria will be applied:

→ for places covered by scholarship the evaluation of the economic situation prevails according to the ISEE, as determined according to the Prime Ministerial decree 5 December 2013, n. 159;

→ for candidates not covered by scholarship the youngest candidate prevails.

In case of a useful placement in several rankings, the candidate will have to exercise an option for only one Ph.D. course simultaneously communicating the renunciation for the other courses.

In case of renunciation of enrollment within one month from the beginning of the first year of course by the entitled persons, the vacant places are assigned to those who hold a useful position in the merit ranking, taking into account, where necessary, the specific area research related to financing.

ART. 10

Methods of enrollment in courses

Starting from the day following the publication of the rankings on the website, the winners will have 15 (fifteen) days, natural and consecutive, to register for the doctorate, under penalty of forfeiture.

In order to complete the matriculation, candidates who are usefully placed on the list (and who have never been registered at this University) must first register on the student portal, which can be accessed from the UNIMOL homepage → Student portal and online services → "Registration" button in the left menu, also including your e-mail address.

Subsequently, candidates who hold a university degree obtained at another University must communicate to the following address antonietta.diiulio@unimol.it the data relative to the high school diploma and the degree (three-year and specialized / magistrale) held.

It will be the responsibility of the Student Secretariat to send, by e-mail, the application for matriculation.

This application must be printed and delivered to the Student Registrar of Campobasso with attachments: a passport size photo (to be authenticated) and a signed copy of a valid identity document.

For information on the matriculation procedures, please contact the Student Secretariat at 0874/404575 or at 0874/404838.

Pursuant to the current Regulations on Student Contribution of the University of Molise, students of research doctorates who are not PhD scholarship recipients and PhD students with disabilities must

make only the payment of the first installment including stamp duty and of the regional tax by the date of maturity of registrations and registrations.

Students enrolled, for the academic year 2018/2019, to the PhD Program - XXXIV cycle which are beneficiaries of a PhD scholarship must make, by the deadline established for enrollment and registration, the payment by MAV bulletin, of the first installment of equal amount to € 156.00 which includes the regional tax and stamp duty, and, within the deadlines of January 31, March 29 and May 31, 2019, the payment of the annual all-inclusive contribution in three installments of the same amount and amount different according to the ISEE value of the belonging family nucleus according to the amounts that will be determined in the new Regulations Fees and Contributions academic year 2018/2019.

They can also provide for the payment of the amount due using the electronic payment systems - pagoPA, or they can directly contact the offices of the right to study for payments via POS with credit or debit cards.

The University Administration assumes no responsibility for the case of the dispersion of applications for reasons not attributable to the Administration itself.

Those who have not taken steps to regularize their position within the set deadline will be considered as RENOUNCED for all purposes and the vacant posts will be assigned to other candidates, according to the ranking order.

ART. 11

Scholarship

The scholarships, in the number specified in the schedule of each course, will be assigned according to the ranking order for each of the various curricula provided for in each PhD and up to the coverage of the places available for each PhD program.

The number of scholarships indicated in the individual cards may be increased, within the maximum limit of sustainable places for each course, following funding, obtained from public and private bodies interested in supporting qualified research activities, which become available after publication of this announcement and before the comparative selection procedure is completed.

However, the deadline for the submission of applications for participation in the competition, as per art. 4 of this announcement, any increase in the number of scholarships will be made known exclusively through the integration of the individual cards, published on the web page "Doctorates" → Tenders of the "Research" section of the website <http://www.unimol.it> and on the University Register.

The scholarship is paid exclusively to those who do not possess, over the tax years of prevalent use of the scholarship, an annual income exceeding the amount of an annual stock exchange rate equal to euro 15,343.28. The exceeding of the income limit determines the loss of the scholarship right for the year in which the income event incompatible with the scholarship occurred. In this case there will be an obligation to return the monthly payments already perceived.

With the same merit, for the awarding of scholarships the assessment of the economic situation determined in accordance with the current legislation on the right to study prevails. In case of further parity, the youngest candidate is registered.

The annual amount of the scholarship, pursuant to Ministerial Decree n. 40 of January 25, 2018, is set from January 1, 2018 in € 15,343.28, is subject to the social security contribution INPS Gestione Separata pursuant to current legislation and is exempt from IRPEF pursuant to art. 4 of the Law of 13 August 1984, n.476.

The payment period of the scholarship is monthly postponed.

The scholarships have an annual duration and are renewed on the condition that the student has passed the annual checks carried out by the Board of Statutory Auditors pursuant to the current regulations in force.

In case of renunciation or forfeiture within one month from the start of the courses, the doctoral student is not entitled to the stock exchange rate or to the provision of another form of financing.

Pursuant to art. 11 of the current " University Regulations for Research Doctorates of the University of Molise" , the amount of the scholarship is subject to a 50% increase for periods of stay abroad for research activities , up to a maximum of 18 months over the three-year period of the doctorate. The stay abroad must be authorized by the Academic Board or by the Coordinator, except as provided for by specific agreements or agreements for the internationalization of doctorates.

Scholarship holders are not assigned a budget for research activity of no less than 10% of the annual amount of the grant from the second year onwards.

The scholarship can not be combined with research grants and other scholarships awarded for any purpose, with the exception of those granted by national or foreign institutions useful for integrating the research activity of the grant holder with stays abroad.

PhD students who have previously benefited from PhD courses on the same subject or on similar subjects can not qualify for doctoral scholarships.

In the case of scholarships not assigned to the winners of the competition, the same will be awarded to eligible candidates with the right according to the order of the relative ranking.

Pursuant to art. 11 of the " University Regulations on the Ph.D. program of the University of Molise", the amount of the scholarship is subject to a 50% increase for periods of stay abroad, up to a maximum of 18 months over the three-year period of the doctorate. The stay abroad must be authorized by the Academic Board, except as provided for by specific agreements or agreements for the internationalization of doctorates.

ART. 12

Incompatibility and connection with medical specialization schools

The enrollment in PhD courses is incompatible with the simultaneous enrollment in degree courses, in non-medical specialization schools, in courses for active training courses (TFA), or other doctorate courses in Italy or abroad. except in cases of specific international agreements.

Students enrolled in undergraduate or graduate courses, which, having title, intend to enroll in a PhD course, are required to request temporary suspension of their career.

The enrollment of a doctoral student in training courses, master classes and masters can be authorized, upon request by the person concerned, by the Academic Board only if the activities covered by these professional courses are assessed as useful for the research activity required to obtain the title of Doctor of research.

The joint attendance of the PhD program and of a medical specialization course is permitted in compliance with the provisions of art. 5 of the current " University Regulations on the Ph.D. program of the University of Molise".

ART. 13

Obligations and rights of doctoral candidates

Students enrolled in the PhD Programs have the obligation to attend courses and to carry out research and study activities in the structures designed for this purpose.

The Doctoral Program implies an exclusive full-time commitment, without prejudice to the possibility of carrying out tutoring activities for students of the Laurea and Laurea Magistrale courses and supplementary teaching activities within the maximum limit of forty hours in each academic year, in accordance with the current legislation. Regulation on the PhD program of the University of Molise, prior authorization from the Faculty Board and without this leading to any increase in the scholarship.

Doctoral students in the medical area can participate in clinical-care activities.

The additional obligations and rights of the students are contained in the current " University Regulations on the Ph.D. program of the University of Molise".

ART. 14

Final exam and achievement of the title

The title of "Doctor of Research" ("Dott.Ric." Or "Ph.D") is obtained at the time of passing the final exam, which can be repeated only once. The exam consists in the presentation of a written dissertation (Research Thesis) which gives an account of an original research that contributes to the advancement of knowledge or methodologies in the chosen field of investigation.

The title of research doctor is issued following the positive evaluation of the research thesis.

ART. 15

Processing of personal data

The processing of personal data provided by candidates collected for the purposes identified in this notice takes place in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation 27.04.2016 n.679 (General

Data Protection Regulation , following: GDPR).For the purposes of processing personal data, the University of Molise is the data controller under the GD PR, art.26.
