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Art.1
Ph.D. Programmes

The University of Molise has published the call for applications for the admission to the Ph.D. Programmes XXXV cycle Academic year 2019-2020, reported in Annex **A, B, C, D, E** which are an integral part of the call.

All the information regarding the competition (curricula, research topics, number of positions, admission requirements, selection procedures and criteria) can be found in Annex A, B, C, D, E.

The number of positions indicated in all the Annexes may be increased if additional scholarships financed by public or private institutions are made available, provided the relative conventional acts are signed within the Ph.D. call expiration date.

The Ph.D. Programmes will officially start on 1st November 2019 and will have a duration of three years.

This announcement is valid as the means of public notification to all intents and purposes.

However, any changes, updates or supplements will be released exclusively through the university web page of the Ph.D. program <http://www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/bandi-in-evidenza/>.

Failure to comply with the rules contained in this announcement will result in exclusion from the selection process.

The University of Molise takes no responsibility for the dispersal of communications dependent on inaccurate indications of personal contact by the applicant or by failure or belated communication of their change or by postal or telematics.

This call is drawn up in Italian and English in accordance with the relevant rules and in the University's Regulations.

Art.2

Admission requirements

All citizen, regardless of sex, age and nationality may apply to be admitted to a Ph.D.:

- Applicants holding a postgraduate degree (Laurea specialistica) as per Italian Ministerial Decree n°. 509/1999, or a postgraduate degree (Laurea magistrale) as per Italian Ministerial Decree n°. 270/2004, or a degree of the former Italian university system, or an equivalent degree obtained abroad;
- Applicants achieving one of the above mentioned degrees within October 31st every year. In this case candidates will be admitted conditionally to the selection procedure and **they must produce the degree certificate within the enrolment's deadline. If not, their enrolment is considered unacceptable.**

All applicants are eligible for selection, subject to verification of self-certified statements pursuant to Presidential Decree n°. 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions. In the case of false declarations, the University will be able to have, at any time, with a reasoned measure of the Rector, the exclusion of candidates from the selection procedure or from the Ph.D. course, subject to criminal responsibilities arising from this.

Applicants with a foreign degree must certify that their qualification would grant them entry to a similar university course in the country where they achieved this qualification.

For that reason, they must:

- apply for the “dichiarazione di valore” (declaration of equivalent value) at the Italian consulate or embassy abroad (the declaration must be applied as soon as possible since consulate or embassy can take a long time to process the request).

If candidates achieving the academic degree required for entry to the doctorate no later than 31 October 2019, pass the selection and are admitted to a doctoral course - after obtaining the title and no more than 30 days from the start date of the course - they will have to send to the Student Secretariat (diulio@unimol.it; cefaratti@unimol.it) a self-certification relating to the achievement of the degree provided with a date and autographed signature (or certification, only in the case of an academic degree obtained in non-EU countries), accompanied by a copy of a document of recognition with valid photo, indicating:

- name of the university that issued the degree,
- date of graduation,
- type of title (pre-existing order, master's degree or master's degree),
- final grade.

Art.3

Academic qualifications obtained in countries other than Italy

The Selection committee is responsible for establishing the eligibility of the foreign degrees for the sole purpose of participating in the selection and enrollment in the Ph.D. program, in compliance with the current and relevant legislation in Italy and in the country where the degree has been issued and with international treaties or agreements for the recognition of qualifications in higher education.

By applying for the selection, candidates implicitly and concurrently request for the verification of the eligibility of their foreign qualifications.

For this purpose, Italian and foreign candidates with a foreign academic degree will have to attach the following documents to the application:

- a) Certificate relating to foreign academic title with the list of exams taken and their grade, accompanied by translation in Italian or English;
- b) Any other document useful to assess the suitability of the title (Diploma Supplement etc.).

Italian or foreign applicants with a degree obtained abroad, if successful, are required to submit by 30th March 2020, subject to exclusion from the course, the “dichiarazione di valore” (declaration of equivalent value) and the certificate relating to the title with exams and votes, translated and legalized by the Italian Diplomatic Representative of the country to which the institution that issued it belongs. The declaration of value must certify that the degree held is valid in the country of achievement for enrolment in an academic course similar to the Ph.D.

If the above equivalent value declaration is not available for the specified date, a document must be submitted proving that the request for release has been forwarded to the relevant Diplomatic Representative. The PhD student must deliver the value statement as soon as possible.

Applicants not holding the required degree are required to attach to the application:

- c) Self-declaration issued as per D.P.R. no.445/2000 reporting the name of the degree and the date will be awarded, list of exams taken and their grade, the date and the number of credits achieved.

All applicants are admitted to the competition conditionally until the requirements for admission have been completely verified. Applicants who do not have the requirements can be excluded any time for justified reasons by the Rector.

Art.4

Application for admission to the public competition

The application for admission to the selection, drawn up in plain paper, according to the attached model and including the mandatory documentation below, should be addressed to the **Magnifico Rettore dell'Università degli Studi del Molise, Area Innovazione e Sviluppo, Via Francesco de Sanctis s.n.c., 86100 Campobasso (Rector of the University of Molise, Innovation and Development Dept.)**, and must be received no later than **September 6th 2019**, via one of the following means:

- ▶ by registered mail with receipt,
- ▶ or certified e-mail (PEC) by sending it to the University of Molise's certified address amministrazione@cert.unimol.it pursuant to and in accordance with the procedures established by the current Italian legislation,
- ▶ or personally handed over to the University's "Ufficio Protocollo" (Information Protocol and Archives Office of the University of Molise) no later than **September 6th 2019**. The application can be delivered at the above-mentioned office on the following days and times: Monday to Friday, from 9.00 to 12.00.

In case of delivering the application by registered mail **THE POSTMARK DATE OF THE RECEIVING OFFICE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED AS A VALID PROOF OF RECEIPT.** Applications received after the given deadline will not be considered.

Applications sent by the given deadline via Certified Electronic Mail to the University of Molise's certified email address: amministrazione@cert.unimol.it shall be considered valid only if the applicant's email address is itself certified (PEC), and, in accordance with the current and relevant laws, applications sent through ordinary email accounts will not be accepted even if addressed to the University of Molise's certified email address.

Foreign candidates or residents abroad shall submit their applications to the following email address phd_receipt@unimol.it no later than **September 6th 2019**.

The application form must include the candidate's personal details, date and place of birth, residence and their preferred domicile for the selection process, as well as their telephone number, e-mail address or certified email address, their citizenship, tax code, the exact name of the Ph.D. program they wish to apply for, its corresponding code and the indication of only one chosen Ph.D. curriculum if Ph.D. programme is structured in "curricula".

In the same application form, candidates must declare the following, pursuant to art. 46 of the Italian Presidential Decree 445 of 28/12/2000:

- ☐ the University where the degree was obtained or will be obtained;
- ☐ the qualification held, the final grade and date of accomplishment;
- ☐ the academic year of graduation;
- ☐ or alternatively the statement that the required qualification will be presented by October 31st 2019;

- ☐ or alternatively, in case the qualification was obtained from a non-Italian university, the name of the foreign qualification to be evaluated for equivalence to the required Italian qualifications;
- ☐ not to be enrolled in another doctoral course;
- ☐ that the candidate is not simultaneously enrolled in other courses (undergraduate course, non-medical specialization course, postgraduate degree or diploma course, another specialization course) which is incompatible with the Ph.D. course, or, if so, that they commit to suspend their attendance to such incompatible course for the entire duration of the Ph.D. program;
- ☐ knowledge of a foreign language.

The application must include the following mandatory documents:

1. If the qualification was awarded in Italy: diploma supplement or self-declaration issued as per D.P.R. n° 445/2000 concerning holding a degree, containing the list of exams taken, their marks and date, the number of credits, the scientific subject sectors, the name of the University which issued the degree, the date and the final grade.
2. If the qualification was awarded abroad (equivalent to an Italian postgraduate degree) which has not yet been recognized as equipollent to an Italian degree: diploma supplement or certificate of the foreign qualification (which should be translated into English if it is in a language other than Italian or English), containing the list of exams taken, their marks and date, the number of credits, the date the degree was awarded and the final grade.
3. Applicants not holding the required qualification yet, are required to attach a self-declaration issued as per D.P.R. n° 445/2000 or a certificate concerning the degree description and the date will be awarded, the list of exams taken, their marks and date and the number of credits.
4. A photocopy of a valid ID document.
5. A signed Europass-format Curriculum vitae et studiorum (the Europass template can be downloaded at: <https://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/it/documents/curriculum-vitae>).
6. The qualifications and documents that may be deemed useful for admission and a list of all the presented documentation. The list must be subscribed.
7. Scientific publications and a list of all the publications attached to the application. The list must be subscribed.
8. **The applicant's research project with a title (only if required by the selection tests specific to each PhD Program).**

Publications in languages other than Italian, English, French, German and Spanish must be presented in their original language and translated into Italian.

In the case that they are in a language other than Italian, English, French, German and Spanish, certificates issued by the competent authorities of the State of which the foreign applicant is a citizen must be translated and legalized by the competent Italian consular bodies.

For foreign scholarship holders, a certificate confirming their entitlement to the scholarship funded by a foreign country must be attached to the application.

Applications that are still incomplete with regard to the application form/forms and/or in the mandatory attachments at September 6th 2019 will be excluded.

Applications that are incomplete, irregular or not transmitted according to the terms and conditions of this article will not be considered valid.

Applications containing undated and/or unsigned self-certifications will also be excluded.

Any supplementary documentation received after the deadline will be NOT accepted, under any circumstance.

ART. 5

Candidates with disabilities

Pursuant to Law 104/92, as supplemented by Law 17/99, and Law 170/2010, applicants with disabilities or Specific Learning Disorders (DSA) can support, where provided in the selection process for admission to the chosen doctorate, the admission test with personalized supports. These applicants, must make a request by completing the form available at the following link <https://www.unimol.it/wp-content/uploads/2015/07/MODULO-RICHIESTA-AUSILI-NUMERO-POGRAMMATO2.pdf>. The form completed in all its parts must be attached to the application form and sent strictly within the deadline of the present call, specifying the supports, aids or compensatory measures required (additional time for written tests).

It is also mandatory to attach to the abovementioned form the certifications related to disability or DSA as well as the documentation useful for the purpose of personalized supports such as certification pursuant to Law 104/1992; the certification of civil disability; the certification diagnosis of DSA issued after the majority of age by structures of the NHS or by specialists and facilities accredited by the same. The request must be drawn up following the indications available in the online application procedure for the selection.

Sensitive data will be kept and processed with the confidentiality provided for by the European Regulation n.679/2016.

ART. 6

Selection procedure

The selection procedure, the specific admission requirements and the dates of the examinations are mentioned in the Annexes related to each Ph.D. programme, which are an integral part of this announcement and are published in the university web pages of the Ph.D. on the website <http://www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/>. The information provided in the Annexes constitutes an official convocation for all legal purposes.

The dates of the examination is an official convocation, therefore the candidates will not receive any other convocation or communication regarding the exams. For the selection, candidates must present themselves at the venue, day and time indicated in the aforementioned annex, showing a valid identification document (identity card, passport, driving license). Candidates are not required to participate in the evaluation of qualifications.

The oral examination, only and exclusively if foreseen in the annex concerning the chosen doctoral course, can be carried out also in a language other than Italian. Any oral examination is public.

The attribution of the scores to the individual evaluation, including the minimum score to be admitted to any written or oral exams, is indicated in the annexes relating to the individual Ph.D. courses.

The result of the evaluation will be available on the webpage at <http://www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/>, starting from the date declared in the specific annex of each Ph.D. course.

The final score is given by the sum of the points reported in the evaluation of the titles and of the eventual written and / or oral exam.

Special provisions for candidates residing abroad: candidates residing abroad, can take the oral exam at a distance, only and exclusively if provided in the Ph.D. program annex, using the videoconferencing tool (Skype) or similar system. Applicants residing abroad, wishing to make use of videoconferencing for oral examination, must make a request by filling in the form attached to this announcement. To the filled form, applicants must attach a recent color passport size photo. Furthermore in the application form, applicants must indicate their Skype contact and declare their will to ensure the use of a webcam to allow their identification to the Committee of selection. The candidate must be available at the personal address, previously communicated, on the day for the oral examination, according to the indications given in the calendar published on the website indicated in the form. The Committee has the right to agree with the candidate a precise timetable for the interview. **For identification purposes and under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure, each candidate is required to identify himself, by presenting the same identity document already transmitted, as a copy, as an attachment to the application.** The failure to communicate the personal address, the lack of connection, the unavailability of the candidate on the day or at the scheduled time or the failure to display a valid identification document pursuant to the preceding paragraph are grounds for exclusion from the selection procedure.

The University of Molise declines any responsibility for the possibility that technical reasons prevent the regular conduct of the oral examination.

Oral examination in videoconference, such as those carried out in presence, are public.

ART. 7

Selection Committee

The Committees for the selection of applicants to the Ph.D. program will be appointed in compliance with Regulations of Research Doctorate Programmes of this University.

The aforementioned Committees are required to timely complete their work in order to allow for the approval of the pertinent acts within September 30th 2019.

Their composition can be consulted at <http://www.unimol.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca-2/>.

The Examination Committees will not send any personal communication to the candidates regarding the outcome of the competition tests: it will be the sole responsibility of the candidates to inform themselves as described in the previous articles of this announcement.

ART. 8

Ranking

Candidates will be admitted to the Ph.D. Programme, after the approval of the selection documents, according to the ranking order for each of the various curricula included in each Ph.D. program and up to the coverage of the positions available for each Ph.D. program.

In the event that, in the ranking for a single curriculum, not all the positions available are covered, the Committee will perform a comparative evaluation of the scores of candidates who are eligible in the ranking of the other curricula of the same doctorate in order to cover all the available positions.

The rankings, after the approval of the selection call reports, will be available on the "Doctorates" page → Bandi of the "Research" section of the website <http://www.unimol.it> and on the University Register.

The publication of the ranking list has the value of official communication in all respects and no communication will be sent to the candidates regarding the publication of the ranking list and the deadline for enrollment.

In case of equality of position in the ranking list, it precedes the youngest candidate according to the art. 2 co. 9 of Law 191/1998, without prejudice to the criterion of precedence provided for the award of the Ph.D. scholarship, reported in art. 9 of this announcement. If the candidate is selected in several rankings, he / she will have to opt for only one doctoral course. The choice of the doctoral course, carried out at the time of enrollment, is final and will not be possible to make changes.

ART. 9

Admission to courses

Candidates will be admitted to the Ph.D. course according to their position in the ranking, up to the coverage of all the available positions.

A separate ranking is provided for positions reserved to scholarship holders from foreign institutions and graduates in foreign universities.

ART. 10

Enrollment

Starting from the day following the publication of the rankings on the website, the selected candidates will have 15 (fifteen) days, natural and consecutive, to register for the doctorate program, under penalty of forfeiture.

The successful candidates, who have accepted their enrollement according to the procedures, will automatically be formalized as soon as the Ministry of Education, University and research sets out the requirements for Ph.D. Programmes for the 2019-2020 academic year.

In order to complete the enrollement, candidates who are usefully placed on the ranking list (and who have never been registered at this University) must first register on the student portal, which can be

accessed from the UNIMOL homepage → Student portal and online services → " Registration " button in the left menu, also including your e-mail address.

Subsequently, candidates who hold a degree obtained at another University must communicate to the following address antonietta.diiulio@unimol.it the information on the high school diploma and the degree (three-year and specialized / magistrale) held.

It will be the responsibility of the Student Secretariat to send, by e-mail, the application for enrolment.

This application must be printed and delivered to the Student Registrar of Campobasso with a passport size photo (to be authenticated) and a signed copy of a valid identity document.

Pursuant to the current Regulations on Student Contribution of the University of Molise, students of research doctorates who are not Ph.D. scholarship recipients and Ph.D. students with disabilities must make only the payment of the first installment including stamp duty and of the regional tax by the date of maturity of registrations and registrations.

Students enrolled, for the academic year 2019/2020, to the Ph.D. Program - XXXV cycle which are beneficiaries of a Ph.D. scholarship must make, by the deadline established for enrollment and registration, the payment by MAV bulletin, of the first installment of equal amount to € 156.00 which includes the regional tax and stamp duty, and, within the deadlines December 10 2019 (II installment), January 31 2020 (III installment), March 31 2020 (IV installment) e May 29 2020 (V installment), according to the amounts determined in the Tax and Contribution Regulation academic year 2019/2020.

The payment of the amount due can be done using the electronic payment systems - pagoPA, or by directly contacting the Students offices for payments via POS with credit or debit cards at the sector of the Right to Education Sector - Taxes and Contributions.

The University Administration assumes no responsibility for the case of the dispersion of applications for reasons not attributable to the Administration itself.

Those who have not taken steps to regularize their position within the set deadline will be considered as RENOUNCED for all purposes and the vacant positions will be assigned to other candidates, according to the ranking order.

ART. 11

Sovereigns

According to Article 17 paragraph 1 of the current University Regulations on Ph.D. with the agreement of the Ph.D. Board, which verifies the consistency of the research topic with aims of the Ph.D. program and the scholarship holder's suitability for admission, are allowed in an outnumber the applicants holders of fundings to support research in the international.

ART. 12

Scholarship

The scholarships, in the number specified in the annex of each course, will be assigned according to the ranking order for each of curriculum in each Ph.D. and up to the coverage of the positions available for each Ph.D. course.

The number of scholarships indicated in the annexes may be increased, within the maximum limit of sustainable positions for each Ph.D. course, following funding, obtained from public and private bodies interested in supporting qualified research activities, which become available after publication of this announcement and before the comparative selection procedure is completed.

The scholarship is assigned exclusively to students who do not possess, over the tax years of prevalent use of the scholarship, an annual income exceeding the amount of an annual stock exchange rate equal to euro 15343,28. The exceeding of the income limit determines the loss of the scholarship right for the year in which the income event incompatible with the scholarship occurred. In this case there will be an obligation to return the monthly payments already perceived.

For the scholarships awarding, in the case of equal merit, the assessment of the economic situation determined in accordance with the current legislation on the right to study will prevail. In case of further parity, scholarship will be assigned to the youngest candidate.

The payment period of the scholarship is monthly postponed.

The scholarships have an annual duration and are renewed on the condition that the student has passed the annual evaluation carried out by the Ph.D. board and the admission to the following year.

In case of renunciation or forfeiture within one month from the start of the courses, the PhD student is not entitled to the grant instalment or other form of funding.

Under art. 19 paragraph 2 of the current "Regulations for Research Doctorates of the University of Molise", the amount of the scholarship is subject to a 50% increase for periods of stay abroad for research activities. This period may be up to a maximum of 18 months over the three-year period of the doctorate. The stay abroad period must be authorized by the Ph.D. program Board or by the Coordinator, except as provided for by specific agreements or agreements for the internationalization of doctorates.

Under art. 19 paragraph 8 of the current Regulations for Research Doctorates of the University of Molise, from the second year on each Ph.D. student, is guaranteed a budget for research activities in Italy and abroad of no less than 10% of the grant. This budget is not provided for fellows from foreign states or recipients of financial support under specific mobility programmes in relation to the specific regulations.

The scholarship can not be combined with research grants and other scholarships awarded for any purpose, with the exception of those granted by national or foreign institutions useful for integrating the research activity of the grant holder with the periods abroad.

Ph.D. students who have previously benefited from Ph.D. courses on the same subject or on similar subjects can not qualify for doctoral scholarships.

In the case of scholarships not awarded to the selected candidates, they will be awarded to eligible applicants who are eligible according to the order of the relevant ranking

ART. 13

Incompatibility and connection with medical specialization schools

The enrollment in a Ph.D. programme is incompatible with simultaneous enrollment in any other Ph.D. programme, academic course, specialisation school and Bachelor's and Master's programme, either in Italy or abroad, as indicated in the national and internal Regulations on Ph.D. Programmes. The joint attendance of the Ph.D. Programme and a Medical Specialization Course is permitted in compliance with the provisions of the art. 5 of the current *"University Regulations on Ph.D. Programmes"*.

ART. 14

Obligations of Ph.D. students

During the programme, Ph.D. students are requested to attend study and research activities as established by the Ph.D. Board in accordance with the University Regulations on Ph.D. Programmes.

By the end of each academic year, the Ph.D. student is required to present the study and research activities carried out and the results obtained to the Ph.D. Board. The positive assessment involves the passing of the Ph.D. student to the following year.

The Ph.D. Program implies an exclusive full-time commitment, without prejudice to the possibility of carrying out tutoring activities for students of the Laurea and Laurea Magistrale courses and supplementary teaching activities within the maximum limit of forty hours in each academic year, in accordance with the current legislation. Regulation on the Ph.D. program of the University of Molise, prior authorization from the Ph.D. Board and without this leading to any increase in the scholarship.

Doctoral students in the medical area can participate in clinical-care activities.

The additional obligations and rights of the students are contained in the art. 24 of the current *"University Regulations on Ph.D. Programmes"*.

ART. 15

Final exam and achievement of the title

For the application for admission to the final exam and for the achievement of the title of "Doctor of Research" is referred to art. 32 of the current University's Ph.D. Regulations.

At the end of the debate, the thesis, with reasoned collegial judgment, is approved or rejected.

The Candidate who has passed the final exam will be awarded the title of "Doctor of Research" ("Dr.Ric." or "Ph.D.") and will be issued a diploma that will report the wording of the Course and any curriculum attended.

The Commission, by unanimous vote, has the right to award praise in the presence of results of particular scientific importance

ART. 16

Processing of personal data

The processing of personal data provided by candidates collected for the purposes identified in this notice takes place in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation 27.04.2016 n.679 (General Data Protection Regulation , following: GDPR). For the purposes of processing personal data, the University of Molise is the data controller under the GD PR, art.26. The University of Molise is therefore required to put in place appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure that the treatment is compliant with the GDPR, verifying and periodically updating the data protection policies pursuant to the GDPR, arts. 24-25; it is also subject to all the obligations of the data controllers, in particular that of the release to the interested parties of specific information pursuant to the GDPR, art.13-14. The provision and collection of data is mandatory for the selection process and, in the case of sensitive data, it is carried out pursuant to Law 68/1999 and Law 104/1992. The provision of the data indicated in the notice is mandatory and necessary for the purposes of assessing the admission requirements and the formulation of the rankings, for example the exclusion from the selection .The data collected will be kept for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are processed ("conservation restriction principle " GDPR, art.5).

Responsible for the procedure
