





UNIMOL for Ukraine

General provisions

In solidarity with Ukraine, the University of Molise offers 18 full scholarships to Ukrainian students, PhD candidates and contribution in kinds for academics whose studies and research have been compromised due to the present conflict and are forcibly displaced from their home institution.

Students' application

UNIMOL offers 12 scholarships to Ukrainian students regularly enrolled in Bachelor or Master's degree courses at home institutions. Scholarships offered by UNIMOL amount to EUR 500 per month. Their duration is 5 months, renewable.

Accommodation is provided by the University of Molise.

You can register for single learning activities at UNIMOL with exemption from fees if you meet the following requirements:

- You hold Ukrainian citizenship or reside in Ukraine for study purposes
- You are currently a student enrolled in a University degree course
- You have adequate level of knowledge of either English or Italian

Application times and procedures

Applications shall be submitted no later than 25 March 2022.

Acceptance

All beneficiaries will be notified by email. They must confirm their acceptance no later than 7 days from the reception, under penalty of loss of the scholarship.

Documents to be attached to the application:

- copy of passport
- transcript of records
- immunization records

All documents must be in English or Italian. All documents in any language other than English or Italian shall be translated on plain paper.

Academics' application

UNIMOL offers 4 contributions of the duration of 5 months, (accommodation, subsistence and office) for Ukrainian researchers, professors, lecturers, teachers.

Academics and researchers may apply as visiting academics at UNIMOL under the following conditions:

- they hold Ukrainian citizenship or reside in Ukraine for the purposes of their profession
- they hold a permanent position as teachers or researchers at home universities
- they possess adequate level of knowledge of either English or Italian
- they belong to an area of research and teaching that is compatible with the teaching offer and the research scopes at UNIMOL

Application times and procedures

Applicants shall send their resume and a description of their activities at home university by email to the address <u>protocollo@unimol.it</u> no later than 25 March 2022.

A passport copy shall be attached.

All documents must be in English or Italian. All documents in any language other than English or Italian shall be translated on plain paper.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please be informed that should the number of applications exceed our offering, UNIMOL reserves the right to accept academics and researchers on a first come first served basis.

PhD candidates' application

UNIMOL offers 5 grants to Ukrainian PhD candidates enrolled in Institutions having seat in Ukraine. The grants offered amount to to EUR 500 per month. Their duration is 5 months, renewable.

PhD candidates may apply under the following conditions:

- they hold Ukrainian citizenship or reside in Ukraine for the purposes of their PhD program
- they are regularly enrolled in a PhD program in one university having seat in Ukraine
- they possess adequate level of knowledge of either English or Italian
- their PhD program is compatible with UNIMOL offer concerning doctorates

Application times and procedures

Applicants shall send their resume and a description of their PhD program at home university by email to the address <u>protocollo@unimol.it</u> no later than 25 March 2022.

A copy of their passport and their immunization records shall be attached.

All documents must be in English or Italian. All documents in any language other than English or Italian shall be translated on plain paper.
